**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.
- 1.3 The Sailing Instructions may change some RRS-rules. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 spare
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.7 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.

**2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with the class rules.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 2.3 Boats may be required to carry cameras and / or tracking equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the RS Feva class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter before September 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 by registration and full payment with the organizing authority at the website [www.sportinschrijving.nl](http://www.sportinschrijving.nl)
- 3.3 Entries after September 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 may be accepted but an additional fee will be charged.

**4 FEES**

- 4.1 Required fees are € 80,00 per boat
- 4.2 For entries after September 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 but before Saturday 21<sup>th</sup>2019 an additional charge of € 25 will apply.
- 4.3 For entries on Saturday September 21<sup>th</sup> 2019 an additional charge of € 50 will apply.

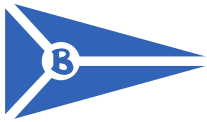
- 6.1 Registration shall take place on:

- 6.2 Each boat shall confirm its entry for the regatta at the regatta office before the start of the first race.
- 6.3 The official opening and competitors briefing will be held at the clubhouse of the WV Braassemmermeer  
Saturday 21<sup>th</sup> 2019 at 09:45 hrs.  
Sunday 22<sup>th</sup> 2019 at 08:45 hrs.

- 6.4 The races are scheduled as follows:

6.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is as follows:

6.6 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:00hrs.

## 7 MEASUREMENTS

A valid measurement certificate for racing and measurement certificates will be checked at registration. In addition, measurement and checks may be made during the event.

## 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available before 21 August 2019 on the website of the Class Organizations and WV Braassemermeer. The Sailing Instructions will also be published at the notice board at the regatta office

## 10 THE COURSES

The diagrams in Attachment B shows the course, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate course length will be 45 minutes.

## 11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## 12 SCORING

12.1 Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

12.3 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

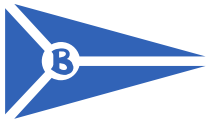
Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park while ashore, unless instructed otherwise.

## 17 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.



## **18 PRIZES**

- 18.1 The whole crew of the winning boat of the championship acquire the title "Dutch Champion" and receive the accompanying medal(s) of the RNWA.  
The whole crew of the winning boat acquires the Blue Pennant of the RNWA.  
The whole crew of the boats that are placed second and third acquire also medal(s) of the RNWA.
- 18.2 Further prizes will be described in het sailing instructions

## **19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

## **21 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

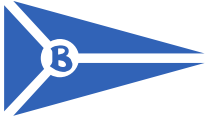
