



## NOTICE OF RACE Open Dutch Championship

J/70 class

organised by **WV Braassemermeer**

under the auspices of the RNWA

from November 1<sup>st</sup> to November 3<sup>rd</sup> (inclusive) 2019

location: Roelofarendsveen

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may contain minor changes to the RRS and the changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.5 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.6 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.
- 1.7 The following J/70 class rules are changed under RRS 87.  
C.3.2.a. is changed as follows: Permitted drivers: there will be no restrictions for a drivers ISAF classification.  
C.5.2.a is changed as follows: 1) One anchor and chain combined not less than 5kg in weight with at least 20m of rode with minimum diameter of 8mm; 5) and 6) The main companionway hatch and dropboard don't need to be carried on board; 7) VHF is not mandatory but optional; 8) One throwable flotation device is not mandatory but optional.  
C5.3.a.1 is changed: No engine is required.

### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 2.2 Competitors may be required to carry on-board cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment on their boats.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the J/70 class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at [www.sailing.today](http://www.sailing.today)

### 4 FEES

- 4.1 Fees are stated in Euro and include any local taxes. Entries including payment received before 1st of October will qualify for the Early Entry fee.

## 6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The race office will be open for registration on Friday November 1<sup>st</sup> from 08:00 till 11:00

6.2 A total of 14 races is scheduled in the event on November 1<sup>st</sup> to November 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019.

6.3 Warning signal for the first race of the day will be :

6.4 No warning signal will be made after 15:00 on the last day of the regatta.

## 7 MEASUREMENTS

7.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

7.2 During the regatta any boat and its equipment may be subject to inspection at any time.

7.3 The Dutch J/70 class is allowed to organize measurement of equipment inspection. This will be announced in the Sailing Instructions.

## 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the Dutch J/70 class website [www.j70klasse.nl](http://www.j70klasse.nl) and on [www.braassemmermeer.nl/wedstrijden/wedstrijden-2019-informatie](http://www.braassemmermeer.nl/wedstrijden/wedstrijden-2019-informatie) from Thursday October 25<sup>th</sup> 2019. No hardcopy will be handed out at registration.

## 9 VENUE

9.1 The race office is located at the following address: Noorderhem 2, 2371 EC Roelofarendsveen, The Netherlands.

9.2 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and the racing area.

## 10 THE COURSES

10.1 The courses to be sailed will be Upwind Downwind, with a gate and a spreader mark specified in the sailing instructions.

10.2 The target time of the race will be 40 minutes.

## 11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 RRS 44.1 and Appendix P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## 12 SCORING

12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When more than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 13 SUPPORT BOATS

13.1 Class rule 3 of Section I is invoked.



- 14 BERTHING**  
Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the regatta harbour.
- 15 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**  
Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
- 16 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**  
Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.
- 17 RADIO COMMUNICATION**  
Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. The restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 18 PRIZES**
- 18.1** The whole crew of the winning boat of the Dutch championship acquire the title "Dutch Champion" and receive the accompanying medal(s) of the RNWA.  
The responsible person of the winning boat acquires the Blue Pennant of the RNWA.
- 18.2** Prizes will be given to every member of the crew of the first, second and third ranked boat in the event. The J/70 Class Open Dutch Championship Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.
- 18.3** The event will be part of the qualifier series for the Dutch entry spots for the J/70 World Championship 2020. The full qualifying rules will be announced by the Dutch J/70 class
- 19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**  
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 , Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**  
By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
- 21 INSURANCE**  
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.
