



NOTICE OF RACE
Open Dutch Championship
12 M2 Sharpie class
organised by WV Braassemermeer
under the auspices of the RNWA
from **2nd July** to **4th July** (inclusive) **2021**
location: Roelofarendsveen

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* .
The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at http://www.sailing.org/documents/racingrules/national_prescriptions.php.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at [reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf \(watersportverbond.nl\)](http://www.watersportverbond.nl/reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf)) will apply.
- 1.3 The Sailing Instructions may change some RRS-rules. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.5 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.6 All competitors and support persons must adhere to the corona rules of the Dutch government for the for the rules see <https://www.government.nl/topics/coronavirus-covid-19>.
- 1.7 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct. - Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.
- 1.8 All the organizing parties can at any time cancel the event without any reason given.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 26th on the website of the Class Organization <http://www.sharpie.nl/> and WV Braassemermeer <https://www.braassemermeer.nl/>

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the regatta office.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the 12 m2 Sharpie class.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online before June 27th, 2021 at www.sharpie.nl.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees per boat are as follows:

- 5.2 Other fees:
Campers and Caravans are € 12,50 per night. This includes electricity and water on the jetty.
Tents do not require a fee.

9 SCHEDULE

- 9.1 Registration shall take place on Friday July 2nd 2021 from 09:00 hrs to 11:00 hrs.
- 9.2 Each boat shall confirm its entry for the regatta at the regatta office before the start of the first race.
- 9.3 The races are scheduled as followed:

- 9.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is as followed:

- 9.5 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:00 hrs.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 10.1 Each boat shall produce or verify a valid measurement certificate.
- 10.2 Boats may be inspected at any time.

13 COURSES

The course to be sailed will be specified in the Sailing Instructions

14 SPARE

15 SCORING

- 15.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 15.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 15.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

18 [DP] BERTHING

- 18.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the Boat park while ashore, unless instructed otherwise.

19 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 19.1 Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.



20 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

20.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

21 DATA PROTECTION

21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

22.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

23 INSURANCE

23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24 PRIZES

24.1 The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews (there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the event).
