under the auspices of the Royal Netherlands Watersport Association (RNWA)
from 6 September to 8 September 2019
location: Roelofarendsveen

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may contain minor changes to the RRS and will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.5 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International Flying Dutchman class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter before September 6th of 2019 by registration and full payment with the organizing authority.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is €175 per boat.

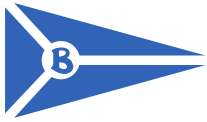

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and a valid measurement form. In addition equipment may be inspected or measured.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be a Triangle – Windward – Leeward course with upwind finish specified in the sailing instructions

10 SCORING

10.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5, 6, 7 or 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 9 or 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park and harbour.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

13 PRIZES

13.1 The whole crew of the winning boat of the championship acquire the title "Class champion Flying Dutchman 2019" and receive the accompanying medal(s) of the RNYU. The responsible person of the winning boat acquires the Red Pennant of the RNYU.

13.2 The sailing instructions may describe more prizes.

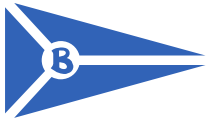
14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15 LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

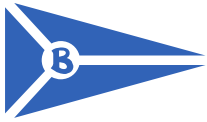

Each boat entered is required to have a third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 1.500,000.-- per event or the equivalent in the currency of the country of registration of the boat.



16 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
